
MISSION STATEMENT

Classes this week, Wed. March 29: 1st – 6th gr. 6:15-7:20p.m. 7th- 8th gr. 7:25-8:30p.m.

In this week's Gospel Jesus heals a blind man. Instead of being amazed at this miracle, the Pharisees try to find fault. They say terrible things about Jesus because He worked this miracle on the Sabbath.

If you talk to your children about this event, ask them to imagine not being able to see since birth. No light, no color, not even the faces of those you love. Jesus happens to pass by and gives this man sight! An enormous miracle, changing every facet of this man's life. Who could possibly find anything wrong with that? Are we grateful for all of the miracles we experience every day? The gift of life, light, color, family, Faith, love and the true presence of Christ in the Eucharist! Do we see the blessings and miracles in our lives or do we look for fault? Try this game with your kids, say, "Jesus open my eyes to all the miracles in my life." Then take turns naming all the blessings around you- seen and un seen.
