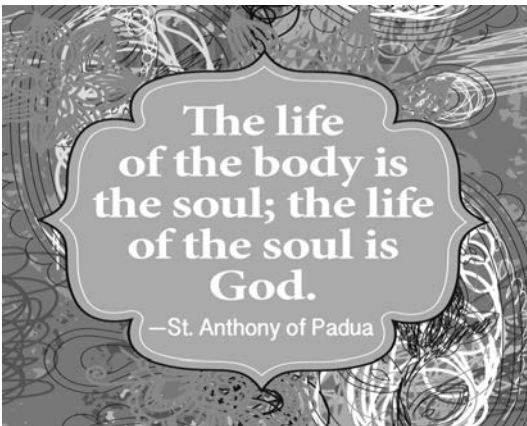

From the Diocese of St. Cloud: A number of parishes in the Diocese of Saint Cloud have recently been named as defendants in lawsuits stemming from the Minnesota Child Victims Act. As you may know, the act removed for three years the civil statute of limitations for historical cases of child sexual abuse. The deadline to file a claim was May 25, 2016.

Our parish has **not** been named in one of these lawsuits.

Most of these lawsuits arise out of misconduct that allegedly occurred many years ago - they are not allegations of recent abuse. No one currently in ministry in the parishes of our diocese has accusations of abuse reported against them.

Attorneys on behalf of parishes and the diocese will work hard for a fair resolution of the lawsuits while allowing the work of the Church to continue. We will work with diocesan staff to keep you informed and updated on any further developments. More information is available at www.stcdio.org.


Please pray for a just resolution to these claims, and for healing for abuse victims and survivors, their families and friends, and our parish communities.
