

**July 18th-22nd there will be no order placed to GLSC.**

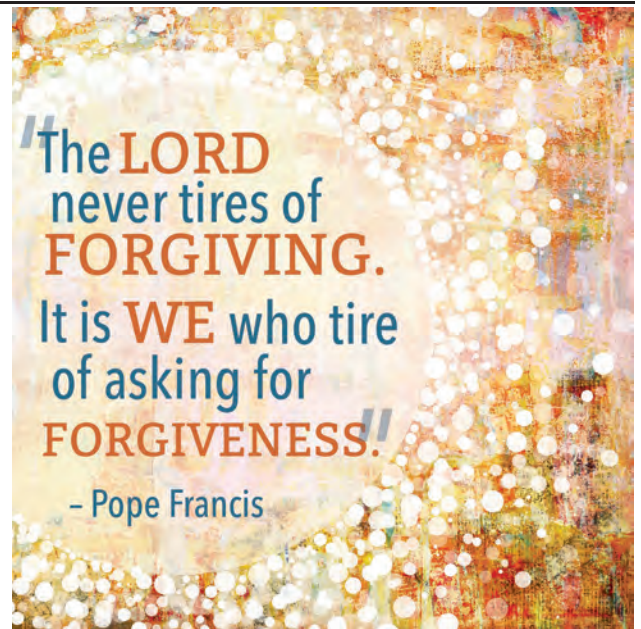
Please place your order by
