**Scrip isn't just** for students its also for our every day shopping. Parish member's, by buying scrip you can donate your 70% back to our parish or school and write that off on your taxes.

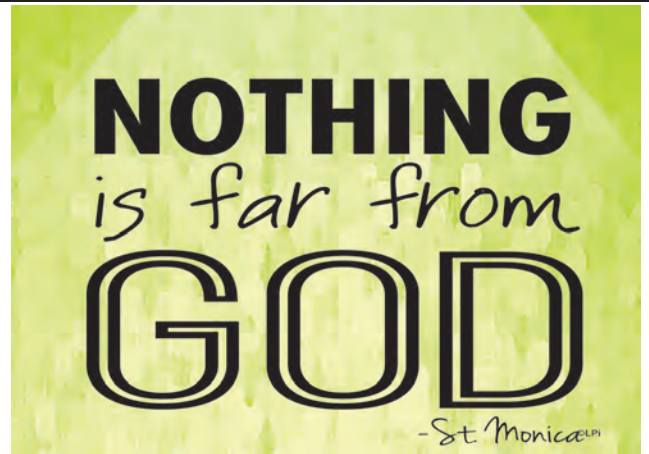
