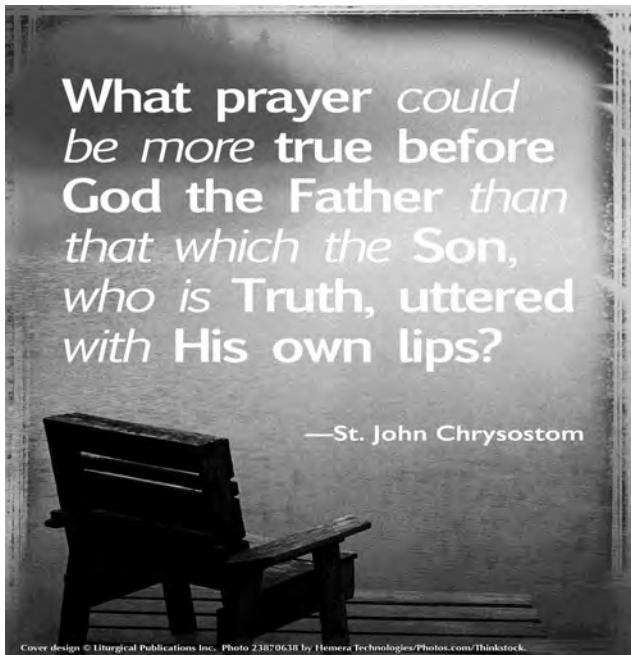

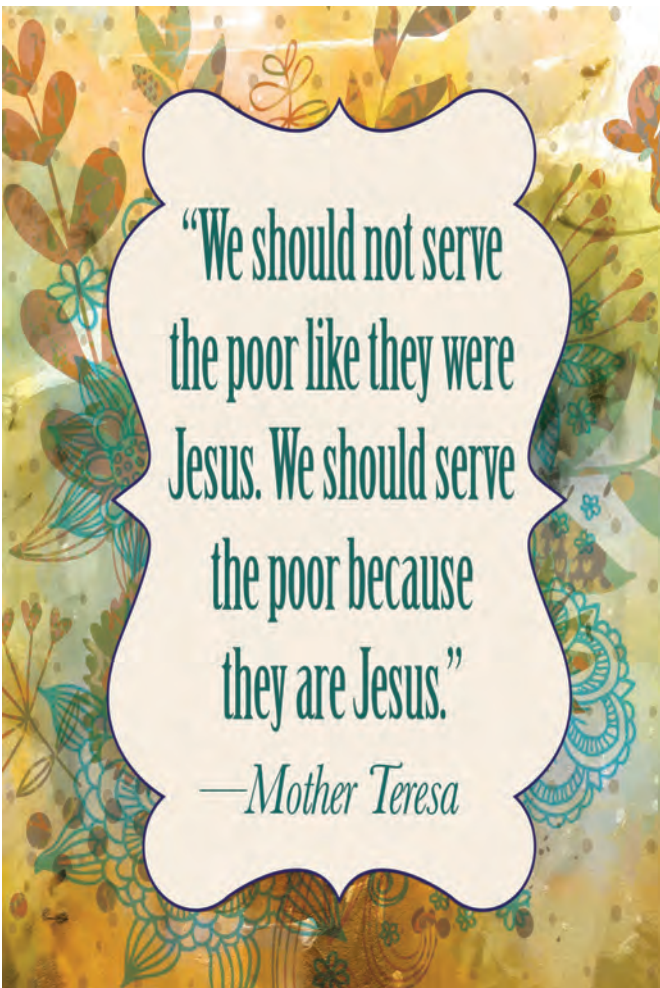


Raffle tickets for the Harvest Celebration
