Even his own people did not know him, his compassion and mission and his purpose. Jesus was so immersed in his mission journey of teaching and healing that his own thought he was out of his mind. His opponents accused him, of his intentions and his deeds. Then Jesus warns against the culpable rejection of his mission and further he redefines the family in the light of his mission and call to discipleship. It is a call to form a new allegiance and to be part of the “family of God.”

How are we related to Jesus? By birth? Or by baptism? Or by faith? Jesus became the beloved son by doing the will of the Father. There is only one way to relate to Jesus. Not by being born a Christian, nor by holding Christian membership, but by doing the will of the father.

Mary became the mother of Jesus by doing the will of the Father. She whole heartedly said: “Behold, I, am the handmaid of the Lord, let it be to me according to your word.” This is the reason for her being the mother of Jesus. For us too, there is no other way to relate to Jesus, but by doing the will of the Father.

Am I mothering Jesus by doing the will of the Father? Am I a brother or a sister to Jesus by doing His will? Being called a Christian doesn’t mean that one is related to Christ. Let us be the householders of Jesus by doing the will of the heavenly Father at each and every moment of our lives. Mary is the true disciple, the disciple par excellence. She is the model for any Christian disciple. ~Fr. Jose

Greetings from SMHOCS!

I am pleased to share the following Year End Update: **STAR Math & Reading Results:** Our students grew an average of 14 months in math this year. 88% of our students are above grade level. On average, our students had over a year's worth of growth in reading. 73% of our students are above grade level.

Professional Development: Our teachers spent the whole year enhancing language arts curriculum. Next year our focus will be assessment data.

Programming: This year we added Spanish. Classes met two days a week! We implemented School Speak for attendance, communication, and our lunch program. We also added one to one devices for grades five and six.

Looking Ahead: We will host an onsite visit next spring and seek re-accreditation through MNSAA. We will be offering all day preschool. We hope to incorporate more features in School Speak and add one to one devices in fourth grade.
