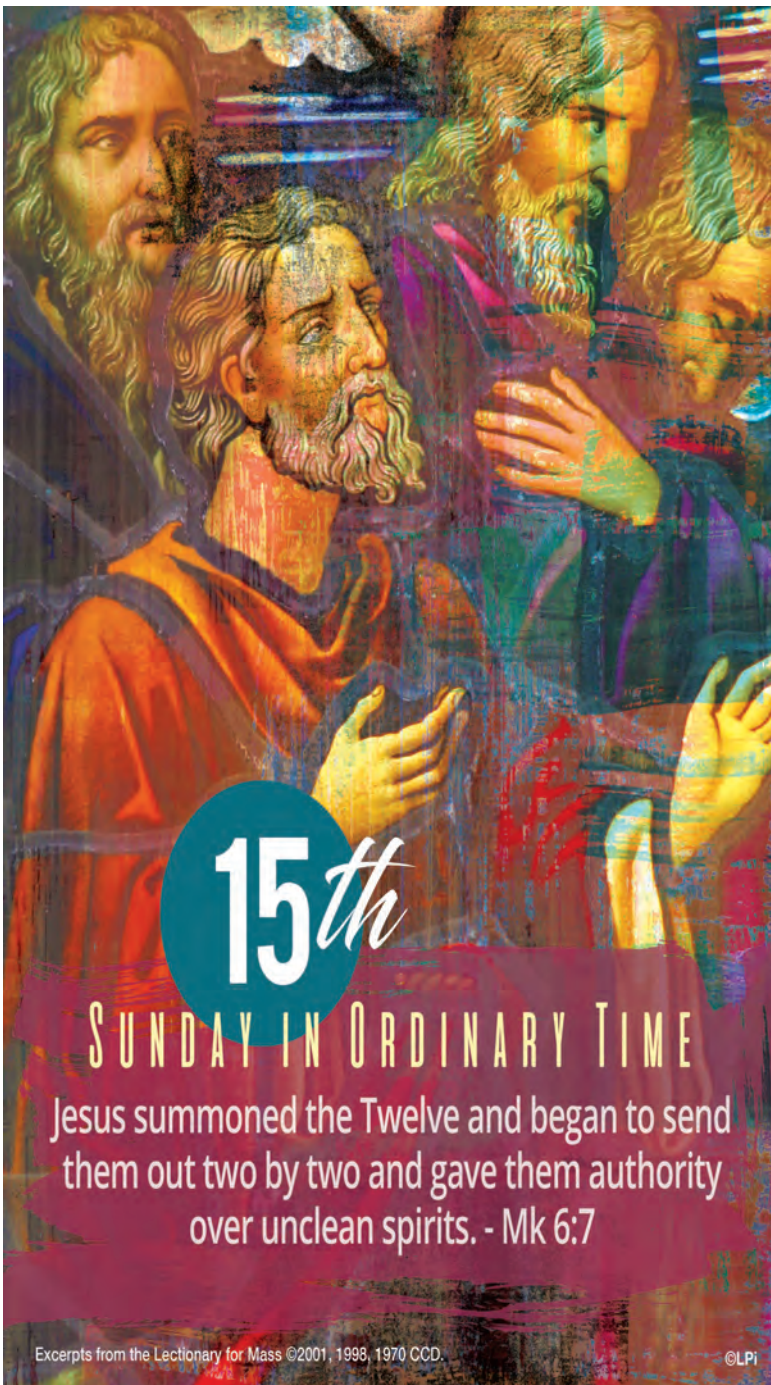

Mk 6:7-13

Jesus carries on His work through the disciples. The instructions Jesus gave to the twelve make four points. First of all, the mission comes from God. Secondly, to proclaim a message effectively, a disciple's lifestyle shall be consistent with the message. Disciple should be a person of authentic words and deeds. For example, a contemporary disciple who claims that there is a human destiny other than the exalted consumeristic life style of the popular media, has to live that conviction. To attack rampant consumerism while yielding to it oneself by accumulating need-less possessions is a contradiction. Pope Francis's life witness inspires us to be more Christ-like.

A third point Jesus makes is that a disciple can expect resistance to the message and personal rejection. Like the prophets, a disciple is not to please the people as a buffoon. He is called upon to pronounce God's will for the people. Some time they will be unpleasant truths. He criticize people for their unfaithfulness and energize them to bring them back to God's ways. Finally, as Mark the evangelist tells us, the disciples are to continue the ministry of the Master bringing Good News of salvation to all. The disciples are to be spokesmen of God as they have received the mandate from Jesus.

"He instructed them not to take nothing on the journey." Why? They need to have complete dependence on God. There will come a day in all of our lives when we realize that nothing that we hold on as precious in our life-name, fame, beauty, wealth, health etc. are not the best of the possessions of our life, but our intimacy with God and our good deeds. Let us be true disciples of Jesus, committed to the mission that He has entrusted to us.
