- 3) On February 11, World Day of the Sick and Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes, at the evening Mass, there will be an opportunity for those who are 7 years of age or older, mentally or physically ill, or infirm with age, to such a degree that they are in proximate danger of death, to receive the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick.
